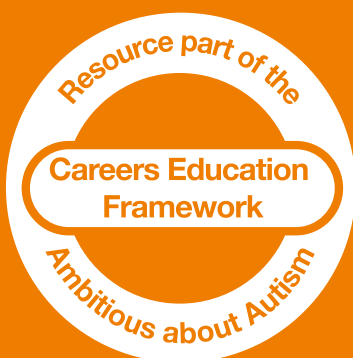


Resources guide
