Clearly explain what students are learning and why.



Allow more time for tasks or exams to account for different processing speeds.



Have structured activities for breaks and lunchtimes, or a quiet place to go.



To avoid corridor crushes, let the student and a buddy out of the lesson a few minutes early.



Think about different types of learning and adapt your teaching resources to **include all methods**.



Allow fidget toys or equipment to help with self-regulation and participation in learning.
